**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On November 30, 2022, Inscription Canyon Water Company (“Inscription Canyon” or “Company”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) for approval of a rate increase.

On December 30, 2022, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Letter of Sufficiency stating that the Company’s application met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-103 and classifying the Company as a Class D utility.

On April 17, 2023, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending approval of Staff’s recommended rates and charges.

On April 27, 2023, Inscription Canyon filed a response to the Staff Report.

On April 28, 2023, by Procedural Order, Staff was directed to file a reply to the Company’s Staff Report response.

On May 1, 2023, the Inscription Canyon Board of Directors submitted a letter to the docket, supplementing the Company’s response to the Staff Report.

On May 5, 2023, Staff filed its reply to the Company’s Staff Report response, modifying some of its recommendations. Staff did not include schedules with its reply, but noted that it would file updated schedules reflecting its revised positions if directed by the Administrative Law Judge

Because Staff has revised its recommended revenue requirement, thus impacting its recommended rates, it is reasonable and appropriate to direct Staff to file revised schedules consistent with its updated recommendations.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Staff shall file revised schedules by May 22, 2023.**

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules  
3 31.1, 31.2, 31.3, 38, 39, and 42 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
5 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Arizona  
6 Supreme Court Rule 42). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all hearings  
7 and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for  
8 discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative  
9 Law Judge or the Commission.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
11 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision  
12 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
14 pursuant to Rule 6(a)(2) or (c) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or  
16 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
17 hearing.

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
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
